

Pitt County Historical Society "Show and Tell"

GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Pitt County Historical Society welcomes any and all interested parties to submit their oddities, treasures, collectibles, and what-have-you for investigation and discussion during its annual "Show and Tell" session at the **Red Banks Primitive Baptist Church**. A panel of antiques experts and enthusiasts will give insight into their provenance, usage, or collectability.

Attendance is open to all at no charge; submission of items is also free. (Please note that this event is neither a sale nor a formal appraisal, although possible value may be discussed.) This year's event is scheduled for **February 7, 2016, from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m.**

Because of the popularity of the event in recent years, the following guidelines have been adopted by the Board of the Society. They respectfully request that contributors of items for discussion, and also anyone attending the event, follow these guidelines:

1. Entrance and exit, both before and during the actual event, should be only through the doors at the front of the church, that is, the Fire Tower Road side of the building. Persons with disabilities or who require assistance may continue to enter and exit via the ramp entrance on the east side of the building.
2. Submission of articles to be reviewed should be **between 2:00 and 2:30 p.m.** prior to the 3:00 p.m. event. One of the panel members will be there at that time to assign a number in the order of submission, and items will be discussed by the panel in that order.
3. The number of items submitted per person shall be limited to two (2); no items will be accepted for showing after the event has started.
